There are no fixed dates to start Phase 1. Candidates who start their VIP Instructor curriculum with Phase 1 are required to complete Phase 4 as an integral part of their training. In this case the total duration of the program (Phase 1, 2, 3 and 4) will be 6 months.

Candidates who do Phase 2, 3 & 4 have more flexibility with respect to the course dates. They can start any date for a schedule of 5 or 6 months in total, as long as it is sure that Phase 3 dates are included in the period (but not in the first 4 weeks).

As a diving instructor you are required to have professional liability insurance before starting to teach or to participate in any Phase 4 activities. This insurance is not included in the price of the course. During Phase 2 you get explanations on the various insurance options. You should be able to find insurance coverage for approximately €160,00

Prices and course dates for parts of the VIP program 2009/2010

VIP Phase 1

To start in Phase 2 of the VIP course, you must have a certification beyond entry level (for example Advanced Open Water Diver or 2* Diver), you must be a certified diver since at least 5 months and you must have proof of an experience of at least 50 dives. If you do not fulfill these requirements, you must do a part of Phase 1 before starting in Phase 2. Contact us to inform us of your first certification date, your certification level and your number of logged dives and we can inform you on the duration and price of the required part of Phase 1.

VIP Phase 2

- If you are already PADI Rescue Diver or an equivalent certification, you start your VIP curriculum 4 days after the indicated starting date from Phase 2. Deduct €400,00 from the Phase 2 course price.
- If you are already a PADI Divemaster or have an equivalent certification, you start your VIP curriculum 14 days after the indicated starting date from Phase 2. Deduct €1.040,00 from the Phase 2 course price.
- If you are a PADI Assistant Instructor or a diving instructor (authorized to certify) from another diving organization, you only do the last 10 days from Phase 2. Deduct €1.750 from the Phase 2 course price.
- If you are a PADI Instructor, but not an EFR and Oxygen First Aid Instructor, you only do the last Thursday and Friday from Phase 2. Deduct €2.990,00 from the Phase 2 course price.

All candidates in the VIP curriculum are expected to have all materials from Phase 1, 2 and 3.
